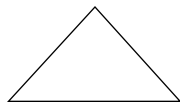
Triangle Inn association

The Venice community created this not-for-profit 501(C) (3) organization to promote the historic landmark called the Triangle Inn, which is listed on the roster of the National Register of Historic Places.

Owned by the City of Venice, the “Inn” was restored with donations of funds, land and in-kind services by citizens, businesses and organizations interested in preserving our local heritage.

The “Inn”, a large triangular shaped structure with an arcade loggia, ornamental detailing and a tower reminiscent of the Italian Renaissance, is an integral element of the Venice area’s cultural charm.

Originally built in 1927 as a rooming house, the “Inn” today introduces visitors and guests to a collection of local historical information. The first floor contains a city museum and the second floor houses the Venice Archives and Area Historical Collection. In addition, the “Inn” is a repository of local family trees and historical documents of local organizations. All contribute to the fascinating annals of our community.

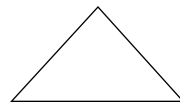
Location
